
Our Timeline Past Achievements

Measuring our Progress

- Our sustainability taskforce will meet every 4 weeks to review progress against our objectives.



April 2025

Based on carbon footprint measurements, carbon reduction plan will have been created which will outline how GHG emissions can be reduced within 1-3 years.

Launched an electric vehicle incentive scheme for UK employees.

August 2025

A longer-term net-zero Policy will have been created which will detail science-based targets and provide a realistic net-zero target date.



Jan 2025

Completed carbon footprint measurement.

Collected sustainability strategies from all partner organisations.

Created improved recyclability resources.



June 2025

Improved the recyclability of our Foodlink range by adopting recyclable product sachets.

Replaced PET (polyethylene terephthalate) sleeve labels from our plastic bottles with PO (polyolefin).



February 2026

Over 50% of Nualtra employees will have completed carbon literacy training and gained carbon literacy certification. Nualtra will become a 'Bronze Carbon Literate Organisation', accredited by The Carbon Literacy Project.
